- >>> The Year was 2008
 - Student Success Program established
 - 10 workshops per year + Orientation
 - Budget: \$0.00





Where it Went

- >>> Within 2-3 years
 - Increase in cross-campus collaborations
 - 55 student success and special events per year
- Within 8 years
 - 115 student success and special events per year
